## Memorsion

This is a registration of the Memorsion installation by Manuel Chantre. The installation with 24 canvas screens offers visitors an immersive experience by means of an array of deconstructed visuals. It functions much like an essay, reflecting the memories of  ${\it places-lost} \ and \ abandoned-by \ displaying \ a \ series \ of \ video \ fragments.$ 

"Memorsion is a tridimensional audiovisual experience made up of twenty-two large cloth canvases assembled to create a unique maze of video projections. It appears as a labyrinth and pictures a fictive urban world. The audience is invited to enter this disturbing environment and meditate on urban architecture and cultural memory."
